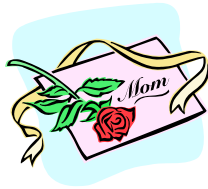

The Archdiocesan Pastoral Strategic Planning Process for parishes is now at the stage where the preliminary recommendations created by the Archdiocesan Advisory Group at their March Retreat for our Cluster 26 (Riverdale/Kingsbridge region) are now being reviewed and discussed by the cluster core team members of the four parishes (our parish along with Visitation Parish, St. Gabriel's Parish, and St. Margaret of Cortona Parish). The letter of Peter was a sermon preached to newly formed Christians. It is a great teaching for us who are believers today. When we consider judgment by God, we sometimes become afraid. Our Christian lives are no different.

With the disciples sitting at table with Christ, may our eyes be opened, our hearts burning, our ears listening as He speaks to us on our sojourn. Like the apostles we repeat 'the Lord has been raised. It is true!' The joy of Easter continues.
