Ten Scriptural Evangelizers

The personal dimension is an important part of evangelization, i.e. "bringing the Good News of Jesus Christ to others." Personal contact, interest in others, and friendly invitations are helpful ways to evangelize. The following list offers some biblical examples.

Mary brings Christ to the world (Luke 1-2)
 John the Baptist points out Jesus as the Lamb of God to the disciples (John 1:35-37)

Andrew brings his brother Simon Peter to Jesus (John 1:40-42)
Andrew points out a boy with bread to Jesus (multiplication of loaves) (John 6:8-9)
Andrew introduces some Greek believers to Jesus (John 12:21-22)
Philip brings Nathaniel to Jesus (John 1:44-46)
The Samaritan woman at the well tells the townspeople about Jesus (John 4:28-30)
Some people bring a paralyzed man to Jesus through the roof (Mark 2:1-12)
Mary Magdalene tells Peter and John about the empty tomb (John 20:1-2)
Peter and John, other apostles and disciples, Paul, and the apostolic missionary efforts of the early Christians (Acts of the Apostles)

Andrew introduce algunos creyentes griegos a Jesús (Juan 12: 21-22)

Philip trae Natanael a Jesús (Juan 1: 44-46)

La mujer samaritana le dice a la gente del pueblo acerca de Jesús (Juan 4: 28-30)

Algunas personas llevan un paralítico a Jesús a través del techo (Marcos 2: 1-12)

María Magdalena le dice a Pedro ya Juan que la tumba vacía (Juan 20: 1-2)

Pedro y Juan, otros apóstoles y discípulos, Pablo y los esfuerzos misioneros apostólicos de los primeros cristianos (Hechos de los Apóstoles)
